Arrival and departure

MALDIVES ENTRY REQUIREMENTS - IMUGA DOCUMENT

Starting 96 hours before your departure (and not before this period), you must complete the Maldives entry form (IMUGA) online on the following official website: <https://imuga.immigration.gov.mv/traveller/declaration>. This document will be requested during check-in at the airport, so we recommend you prepare a printed copy or save it on your phone. This formality is not required for the return journey.

Arrival at Male international airport

Once you have passed through border control and collected your luggage, exit the terminal and head towards the agent holding a SEAFARI sign, either at the airport exit or in front of the information desk. We organize 3 transfers per day to our boat at 10am, 12pm and 3pm. Your activities will begin the following day.

Last day in Male :

Your cruise will end on the morning of the last day with your departure from the boat to the airport after breakfast at 7am. **In case of late flight:**

- luggage storage available at the airport at \$7/bag/day
- day use possibilities in small hotel in Hulhumalé with airport shuttle included (\$30 to \$40/person)
- day trip to nearby island with boat transfer (entrance fee \$25/pax + restaurant, bar expenses, etc.)

Ask your cruise manager on board about the different options available on site.

If you have a domestic flight:

- Previous international flight boarding pass required
- Maximum 25kg checked baggage recommended for divers. Additional kilos US\$5
- Hand luggage 8kg.

Good to know :

- COVID-19 : check the latest travel restrictions to the Maldives
- **No mandatory vaccine** for the Maldives. Please check with your family doctor for more informations.
- Your passport must be valid for **6 month after your return flight**.
- Visa will be given upon arrival.
- **Green tax** per person : US\$120 per trip.
- Service charge package 150\$ (includes crew tips).

Mandatory service charge and greens tax payment is required in cash in Euro or USD onboard.

- Shopping on board must be paid directly cash (euro/USD) or by credit card (Visa/Mastercard).

Eats and drinks

- Full board (international and local cuisine)
- Eat inside or outside on the back deck
- Tea, coffee, drinking water included
- Snacks in the afternoon

Internet

The boat provides a wireless 4G connexion. You have a free acces as long as the signal stays, depending on your route.

Excursions

Depending on your circuit, we do our best to organise a visit of a local island and a barbecue on a deserted island.

Some snorkeling sessions will be offered during the trip. Guides will join if available.

Documents needed

- Dive certification and logbook
- Please check the [MEDICAL QUESTIONNAIRE](#) that you will be asked to complete before the cruise. If in doubt or if you answer "yes" to one or several questions, you must provide a medical certificate of fitness less than one year old.
- Dive insurance
(can be purchased on board for 40\$/week).

Diving

In a nutshell

- 23 dives package included, including 1 night dive
- **No decompression dives / 30m/100ft max.**
- 2 to 3 dives per day
- Aluminium 12L tanks (DIN & Int.) + weights included
- Temperature : water 27°C - 31°C, air 28°C - 34°C

Minimum level required

Due to the **technical difficulty** of some dive sites, we ask for a **CMAS level 2, or a PADI advanced** certification, as well as 50 logged dives.

Dive boat (Dhoni « Seafari Dive »)

- 24m / 28 divers max.
- Shower and toilets
- 3 boat crew members
- Drinking water
- Sundeck
- 2 compressors

Extras

- 15L tank (100cft AL) /trip 40US\$
- Full scuba equipment/trip:
Mask, fins snorkel, BCD, reg., shorty 350US\$
- Dive computer/trip 70US\$
- BCD or regulator/trip 115US\$
- Wetsuit or Mask + fins + snorkel/trip 70US\$
- Surface marker buoy/trip 20US\$
- Lamp /dive 10US\$
- Guide supervision /day 80US\$
- Nitrox course (incl. book and certification) 305\$
- Nitrox 32% **FREE**
