## Circuit and dive sites

### Sites principaux

#### 1- ABU DABAB

*Level : Facile • Depth : 20m • Photo : Macro / G.A*

Shallow coastal site. Exceptional dive for observing green sea turtles and stingray populations. Sandy bottom offering unique biodiversity with pufferfish, seahorses, and various reef fish species. Ideal diving conditions for all levels.

#### 2- SHAAB MARSALA

*Level : Facile • Depth : 15m • Photo : Macro / G.A*

Complex coral reef. Technical dive revealing spectacular vertical walls covered with soft corals. Large populations of parrotfish, Napoleon wrasses, and schools of barracudas. Possible dolphin encounters.

#### 3- SATAYA EAST

*Level : Facile • Depth : 15m • Photo : Macro / G.A*

Exceptional meeting zone with groups of spinner dolphins. Drift dive with moderate currents. Dense coral reefs hosting reef sharks, eagle rays, and tropical fish populations. Unique site for marine mammal observation.



#### 4- GOTA SATAYA

*Level : Facile • Depth : 20m • Photo : Macro / G.A*

Pelagic reef with dynamic currents. Excellent area for observing oceanic sharks, large schools of fish. Coral platforms offering rich habitats for white tip sharks, manta rays, and various reef species.

#### 5- MALAHI

*Level : Facile • Depth : 20m • Photo : Macro / G.A*

Coral site with unique geological formations. Diving between 15 and 20 meters. Habitat for grey sharks, white tip sharks, and eagle rays. Underwater tunnels and cavities rich in marine life, including groupers, parrotfish, and nudibranchs.

#### 6- MAKSOUR NORTH

*Level : Facile • Depth : 40m • Photo : Macro / G.A*

Isolated reef with spectacular vertical walls. Drift dive revealing populations of oceanic sharks and manta rays. Dense coral formations with soft corals and gorgonians. Passage zone for large pelagics and schools of tropical fish.

#### 7- MAKSOUR SOUTH

*Level : Facile • Depth : 20m • Photo : Macro / G.A*

Continuation of the north reef, offering similar diving conditions. Vertical walls covered with diverse marine life. Presence of grey sharks, white tip sharks, and large populations of reef fish. Technical site with moderate currents.

#### 8- CLAUDIA

*Level : Facile • Depth : 20m • Photo : Macro / G.A*

Coral dive site with complex geological formations. Excellent area for observing reef sharks, eagle rays, and grouper populations. Tunnels and overhangs offering refuge to nu-

merous marine species. Suitable for intermediate levels.

### 9- ABU GALAWA SEGHIRE

*Level : Facile • Depth : 20m • Photo : Macro / G.A*

Shallow coral reef with spectacular coral gardens. Accessible to all levels. Habitat for sea turtles, stingrays, and varied populations of tropical fish. Dense coral formations with rich marine biodiversity.

### 10- ABU GALAWA KEBIRE

*Level : Facile • Depth : 20m • Photo : Macro / G.A*

Accessible coral site including the Abu Galawa wreck. Dive offering encounters with white tip sharks and eagle rays. Large populations of groupers and schools of barracudas.

### 11- HAMAM

*Level : Facile • Depth : 20m • Photo : Macro / G.A*

Coral reef with shallow areas and vertical walls. Excellent area for observing sea turtles, reef sharks, and stingrays. Dense coral formations hosting rich marine biodiversity, including butterflyfish, groupers, and fusiliers.

### 12- GOTA SHARM

*Level : Facile • Depth : 20m • Photo : Macro / G.A*

Isolated reef with unique geological formations. Technical dive between 20 and 40 meters. Habitat for grey sharks, white tips, oceanic sharks, and eagle rays. Cavities and overhangs offering refuge to numerous marine species. Spectacular soft corals.

### 13- SHELINIATE

*Level : Facile • Depth : 20m • Photo : Macro / G.A*

Complex coral site with moderate currents. Drift dive revealing populations of white tip sharks and eagle rays. Impressive coral formations with soft corals and gorgonians. Passage

zone for large pelagics and schools of tropical fish.

### 14- HABIL MARSA ALAM

*Level : Facile • Depth : 20m • Photo : Macro / G.A*

Offshore reef with a narrow summit. Technical dive requiring current management skills. Passage areas for whale sharks, white tip sharks, and large schools of pelagics. Vertical walls richly decorated with soft corals and gorgonians.

### 15/16- SHOONA

*Level : Facile • Depth : 20m • Photo : Macro / G.A*

Isolated coral reef with complex geological formations. Technical dive offering encounters with turtles, leopard rays, guitar rays, and sometimes dugongs. Vertical walls and coral platforms host rich marine biodiversity, including groupers, parrotfish, and nudibranch populations.

## Safety first

All aquatic activities are under the supervision of a qualified instructor (CMAS or PADI) of the Seafari team.

Before each activity Instructors on board will make a detailed presentation of the site, currents, wildlife and safety rules to be observed.

The choice of sites is at the discretion of the captain and Seafari Senior Instructor depending on the season and weather conditions.

The senior instructor may impose In water supervision or restriction from diving to any diver whose technical level is not sufficient to guaranty safe diving conditions.
